Explanatory Note:

This Current Report on Form 8-K/A is being filed to amend the Current Report on Form 8-K initially filed by Enterprise Bancorp, Inc. The Company is filing this Current Report on Form 8-K/A solely to correct an inadvertent error in the payout percentage for the Company’s Chief Financial Officer and Chief Operating Officer. Specifically, the last sentence of the seventh paragraph is hereby deleted and replaced with the following: “Additionally, as part of the “Bank wide” incentive group with multipliers, the Chief Financial Officer and the Chief Operating Officer have the opportunity to increase their payouts by up to 15% based on the results of bank wide employee engagement and customer experience scores.” There are no other changes to the information included in the Original Form 8-K.
