(Partner or the Company), a leading Israeli mobile communications operator (NASDAQ and TASE: PTNR),** announced today in a press conference that it intends to commence the soft launching (in the form of Friendly User Trials (FUT)) of its new portfolio of services, thereby taking further step toward realizing the Company's strategy to evolve and develop from a pure cellular operator to a multi-service communications and media service provider.

Alongside the current content and cellular services the Company is offering today, Partner will build a strong presence in the customers' premises through the offering of a broad range of new services including ISP services, mail access, Wi-Fi, fixed telephony through Voice over Broadband (VOB) technology and entertainment multimedia services. These services will be accompanied by innovative and attractive features for the customers' benefit. Partner will also launch the first multimedia portal in Israel, which will offer a wide variety of leading entertainment content including the latest music, movies, TV series and computer games. The new services will be commercially available in the first half of 2009.

Mr. David Avner, Partner's CEO, commenting on the event, said: "Partner's success leans on the tremendous assets built by the Company in the last ten years, which made it a leading cellular company in Israel. Today, the technological developments coupled with the recent trends in consumers' habits enable us to leverage these assets in order to expand our offer to a new and exciting range of superb telecom and media services."

Partner is taking today further step toward realizing its strategy to enter the customers' premises, thereby offering a true added value to its subscribers and strengthening its position as a leading telecommunications company in Israel.
