This year, the

(1) recommended and approved stock compensation grant was for shares having a value not to exceed \$61,000. The number of whole shares is determined using the closing price of a share of stock on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) on the day of the Board of Directors meeting following the Annual Meeting of Shareholders.
