In exchange for the options, the reporting person received an option cancellation payment ("OCP") which was paid one-half in cash and one-half in unregistered shares of the issuer's common stock. The value of the OCP was equal to the difference between the weighted average market price of \$31.75, less the exercise price of the option, multiplied by the number options canceled.
