Represents an award of restricted stock under the Forum Energy Technologies, Inc. 2010 Stock Incentive Plan (the "Plan"). Each share of restricted stock, par value \$0.01 per share, is subject to transferability and other restrictions that lapse upon vesting of the restricted stock.

- (1) The restricted shares vest according to the following schedule: 1/4 vest on each of the first, second, third and fourth anniversaries of the date of grant (2/19/2016). The restricted stock will be forfeited upon a termination of employment prior to vesting, except in limited circumstances. The restricted stock agreement also includes dividend and voting rights.

These performance shares represent a contingent right to receive Common Stock, based on the Company's total shareholder return versus that of the Company's peer group. As determined by the Company's Nominating, Governance & Compensation Committee ("NG&C Committee") and given the Company's total shareholder return versus the relevant peer group over the two-year period commencing on January 1, 2014 and ending on December 31, 2015, each performance share represents the right to receive 0.25 shares of Common Stock.

These performance shares represent a contingent right to receive Common Stock, based on the Company's total shareholder return versus that of the Company's peer group. As determined by the NG&C Committee and given the Company's total shareholder return versus the relevant peer group over the one-year period commencing on January 1, 2015 and ending on December 31, 2015, each performance share represents the right to receive 0.75 shares of Common Stock.

These options are exercisable in accordance with the following schedule: 1/4 of the options become exercisable on each of the first, second, third and fourth anniversaries of the date of grant (2/19/2016).
