- (1) Balance as of December 31, 2004.
- (2) All of these options are vested and exercisable in full.

- (4) One-fifth of these options vest on January 24 of each of the five years beginning in 2002.

- (7) One-fifth of these options vest on January 28 of each of the five years beginning in 2005.
